SOPRANO STAFF SINGER Job Description

Church of the Holy Family is seeking a Soprano Staff Singer to sing with the Adult Choir for scheduled worship services and weekly rehearsals. Holy Family is an equal opportunity employer and is committed to creating an inclusive, safe environment for all employees. This position is available on either an interim or permanent basis.

Holy Family's Adult Choir is a dedicated ensemble of 20 singers who provide music for worship services roughly twice every month. The repertoire selected represents multiple traditions and genres including traditional Tudor anthems, contemporary classical, and spirituals. The choir sings both a cappella and accompanied.

Minimum Qualifications

- Experienced choral singer in small to medium sized ensembles
- Strong sight-reading skills
- Collaborative work ethic and ability to communicate well
- Proficiency in multiple genres and eras of music.
- Vocal range: Soprano — ideally A3-C6.

Desired Skills

- Solo-caliber instrument for occasional solo work as needed

This position is supervised by the Director of Music.

- Wednesday evening rehearsal weekly when full choir is engaged; weekly rehearsal TBD for Staff Sundays.

Salary

This position is contracted at \$50 per rehearsal / service (Wed / Sun) pair (\$100 per week). Additional services during Holy Week, etc., are paid at \$75 per service. For weeks when there is only a service and no rehearsal, the pay is \$75 for the combined rehearsal and service.
